APPROVAL OF PROFESSIONAL ENGINEERING SERVICES ASSOCIATED WITH DESIGN OF AUXILIARY POWER UNITS FOR THE FORNEY CREEK WASTE WATER TREATMENT PLANT AND THIRTEEN (13) SEWAGE PUMPING STATIONS

Jack Chandler, Director of Public Service, presented the Board with the Contract for Engineering Services for the Wastewater Improvements for auxiliary power units for the Forney Creek WWTP, stating that the cost of these engineering services would be \$18,000.

A motion by Commissioner Wilson to approve the Contract with W. K. Dickson for professional engineering services associated with the design of auxiliary power units for the Forney Creek Waste Water Treatment Plant and thirteen (13) sewage pumping stations.

Unanimously approved.

OTHER BUSINESS

Jack Chandler stated that Stan Kiser, County Manager, and he are needing direction on using Consulting Engineers for different projects. He asked if he needed the Board's approval or only the County Manager's. He stated that these projects are time critical.

Chairman Hallman stated that he has an unfavorable opinion of Pease.

A motion by Commissioner Gamble that Jack Chandler, Director of Public Service, get approval from the County Manager on Engineering Services, and the County Manager can bring it before the Board if he has concerns on it.

Unanimously approved.

Commissioner Brotherton stated that he would like the Board to take a look at what the County is offering to pay a County Engineer. He stated that it may need to be looked at.

Commissioner Gamble mentioned hiring an Engineer with the City of Linconton.
