Public Comments: Chairman Hallman advised that this was the time the Board of Commissioners would receive comments from the citizens regarding any matter they desired to address.

Yates Gilbert stated that he wrote a letter to the County Manager about three weeks ago, and has not received a response. He stated that when zoning was first implemented, his property was zoned business instead of residential, and he paid the money and got it changed to residential. He stated that after all his trouble, he got no screening at all. He stated that he has been trying for some time to get this corrected. Mr. Gilbert stated that there are serious problems in the zoning department.

Being no additional speakers, Chairman Hallman declared the Public Comments section closed.

Report from Board of Elections --- Judy Caudill

Judy Caudill stated that the State Board of Elections has suggested that the County Commissioners and the County Board of Elections have a memorandum of understanding. The Board of Elections basically has a personnel policy that the County Attorney helped them with, and it is filed in the Personnel Office.

Ms. Caudill also discussed one stop no-excuse absentee voting. She stated that the Board of Elections may have to ask for a temporary full time employee near the end of the year.

U. S. Department of Commerce Bureau of the Census – Laura McClettie

Laura McClettie stated that her job is to work with the cities and counties to promote census 2000. She stated that this is the only way America knows what America needs.

Ms. McClettie asked that the Board give them a Resolution saying that they are supporting and will support the census count, a complete count committee, and use of facilities for testing. She asked the Board to take a role in just making sure the community is aware of the importance of the count.

Exotic Animal Ordinance:

Chairman Hallman stated that this Ordinance was adopted the 17th day of May, 1999, and has been deferred a couple of times.

Commissioner Waters stated that there is only a copy of the old Ordinance in the packets. He stated that this is not the document the Board was working with at the last meeting on it.

Commissioner Brotherton stated that he remembers a man telling about his monkey that could mow the grass and liked to go fishing, and described the monkey almost like a child. Commissioner Brotherton stated that he is also aware of a situation in Denver where a guy had a monkey that got loose. They guy caught the monkey and the monkey bit him. Commissioner Brotherton stated that this guy had to go to the Emergency Room because of the bite.

The Board had a discussion concerning enforcement by USDA and Lincoln County Animal Control.

UPON MOTION by Commissioner Gamble, the Board voted unanimously to defer this until the January 10, 2000 meeting, with the Inherently Dangerous Animal Ordinance not being implemented until February 1, 2000.

Resolution to Apply for Transportation Grant for NCDOT:

Erma Deen Hoyle requested approval of the following resolution, which needs to be approved as part of the application packet to NCDOT for the monies for the vans for the Human Service Agencies and also for the position of Transportation Coordinator.

UPON MOTION by Commissioner Gamble, the Board voted unanimously to approve the following Resolution:

Applicant Seeking Permission to Apply for CTP Funding, Enter Into Agreement With The North Carolina Department of Transportation And to Provide the Necessary Assurances.

WHEREAS, Article 2B of Chapter 136 of the North Carolina General Statutes and the Governor of North Carolina have designated the North Carolina Department of Transportation (NCDOT) as the agency responsible for administering federal and state public transportation funds; and

WHEREAS, The North Carolina Department of Transportation will apply for a grant from the US Department of Transportation, Federal Transit Administration and receives funds from the North Carolina General Assembly to provide assistance for rural public transportation projects; and

WHEREAS, the purpose of these transportation funds is to provide grant monies to local agencies for the provision of rural public transportation services consistent with the policy requirements for planning, community and agency involvement, service design, service alternatives, training and conference participation, reporting and other requirements (drug and alcohol testing policy and program, disadvantaged business enterprise program, and fully allocated costs analysis);

WHEREAS, Lincoln County hereby assures and certifies that it will comply with the federal and state Statutes, regulations, executive orders, Section 5333 (b) Warranty, and all administrative requirements which relates to the applications made to and grants received from the Federal Transit Administration, as well as the provisions of Section 1001 of Title 18, U.S. C.

NOW, THEREFORE, be it resolved that the Chairman of the Lincoln County Board of Commissioners is hereby authorized to submit a grant application for federal and state funding, make the necessary assurances and certifications and be empowered to enter into an agreement with the NCDOT to provide rural public transportation services.

Presentation of Water Availability Fee

Stan Kiser, County Manager, stated that in the past, there has been some criticism about the deficit the county has incurred in the water fund. This presentation is an alternative method of funding.

Jack Chandler, Director of Public Services, stated that they are attempting to provide an option of generating additional revenue inside the water fund itself, which will reduce the amount of the loan that the water fund has to get from the general fund each year. Mr. Chandler presented the proposal to the Board.

Commissioner Brotherton stated that he would like to get some public input on this before voting on it.

UPON MOTION by Commissioner Gamble, the Board voted unanimously to receive this as information and put it back on the agenda for January 10, 2000.

Chairman Hallman called for a five minute recess.
Chairman Hallman called the meeting back to order.

Grant Application Additional Information:

Capital Improvement Plan

Jack Chandler, Director of Public Service stated that in order to receive additional priority points for our “High User Cost Grant” applications, Lincoln County needs to adopt a 20 Year Capital Improvement Plan. This CIP is not something that must be followed each year but can be used as a guide to assist in developing the budget each year. Obviously needs change and cannot be accurately projected over a 20-year period, which makes it impractical for this CIP to be “written in stone”.

UPON MOTION by Commissioner Waters, the Board voted unanimously to approve the 20 year Water Capital Improvement Plan.

Proposed Water Conservation Incentives

Jack Chandler, Director of Public Service, stated that in order to receive additional priority points for our “High User Cost Grant” applications the following water conservation incentives are proposed.

“Beginning January 1, 2000, Lincoln County will give a \$5.00 rebate for any replacement installation of low-flow faucets, showerheads, and toilets. The rebate will be given one time per water and/or sewer customer and is limited to replacements in existing residences. Proof of the installation will be required in the form of a receipt or billing invoice showing the actual work done. The rebate will be included in the customers’ next billing statement following approval of the County.”

UPON MOTION by Commissioner Saine, the Board voted unanimously to approve the Water Conservation Incentives.

Vacancies: Commissioner Saine presented the following Vacancies.

Calendar: Chairman Hallman presented the Board calendar for January, 2000.

County Commissioners' Report:

Chairman Hallman presented the Resolutions for Nationally Certified Teachers for the Board's approval.

UPON MOTION by Commissioner Brotherton, the Board voted unanimously to approve the Resolutions of Appreciation for the Teachers Receiving National Certification.

County Manager's Report:

Stan Kiser, County Manager, stated that within the next year or so, the County will have to start considering expansion of the Water Plant. To do so will cost an estimated four to five million. That will give us an additional three million gallons per day. He intends to meet with CMUD sometime in January to discuss the possibility of running the lines from Highway 73 to McGuire Nuclear station. At that point, it may be possible to hook on to CMUC and purchase water from CMUD. The estimated cost of the line would be less than a million dollars.

Mr. Kiser stated that we have yet to hire a County Engineer. He stated that he has talked with Jack Chandler about contracting out the engineering work. He stated that when a developer submits a plan, they will be responsible for the cost of the subdivision review. He stated that if these costs are passed along, then the county can absorb the rest of the cost of the Engineer. He stated that he is considering hiring someone with some technical knowledge to assist the work with the Engineers.

Mr. Kiser stated that he has been approached by Gary Bell of Health Management Associates. He handed out information packets from Mr. Bell. Health Management Associates is the organization that runs the Lake Norman Regional Medical Center.

Chairman Hallman stated that he would like to go on record saying that he did not solicit this proposal.

Closed Session: **UPON MOTION** by Commissioner Brotherton, the Board voted unanimously to go into Closed Session for the following purposes pursuant to G.S. 143-318.11:

1. To consult with an attorney employed or retained by the public body in order to preserve the attorney-client privilege between the attorney and the public body, which privilege is hereby acknowledged.

2. To discuss matters relating to the location or expansion of industries or other businesses in the area served by the public body.

UPON MOTION by Commissioner Brotherton, the Board voted unanimously to authorize the Chairman to sign the listing agreement with the Keith Corporation for the Industrial Park property, subject to the basic terms of the 10 percent commission, 2 year term, running from January 1, 2000 to January 1, 2002, with a marketing budget of \$17,500, subject to vouchers and receipts being submitted, and approval subject to the concurrence of the LEDA Executive Board at their meeting on Thursday, December 16, 1999.

UPON MOTION by Commissioner Brotherton, the Board voted unanimously to authorize the Chairman to sign a consent to the listing agreement between the Finger family and the Keith Corporation, with similar terms to just covered.
