System Pressure Advisory!

The water consumers of the Lincoln County Water System in Lincoln County are experiencing periods of low pressure and outages in the distribution system due to a 12" water main break at the intersection of Hwy 16 N Business and Charter Lane. Periods of low or no pressure in the distribution system increases the potential for back siphonage and introduction of bacteria into the water system.

Therefore, the Division of Water Resources advises that when water is restored consumers **boil all water** used for human consumption (including drinking, making ice, brushing teeth, washing dishes and food preparation) or use bottled water.

Vigorous boiling for one (1) minute should kill any disease-causing organisms that may be present in the water.

The Lincoln County Public Works Department is strongly urging the water consumers to conserve water whenever possible. This advisory remains in effect until further written notification is issued.
