



Lincoln County Parks Picnic Shelter

Policies and Procedures

Park picnic shelters are available for reservations at times not designated for recreation programs/public use. Reservations may be made by contacting Lincoln County Parks and Recreation at 704-748-1518 or the East Lincoln Community Center at 704-483-8980 during the hours of 8:30 a.m. to 5:00 p.m.

Reservation applications must be signed by a person at least 21 years of age and the person signing the application will be responsible for the conduct of the group in compliance with the Policies and Procedures of the park. **Payment must be received within 7 days of making the reservation, or reservation may be canceled.**

Any group not complying with the Policies and Procedures of the park will not be considered for future use of the facility and may be asked to leave park.

Lincoln County Parks and Recreation reserve the right to cancel any reservation which is not in the best interest of the County and the Community.

Sales of goods, merchandise, and services are prohibited. Exceptions may be made if approved by county staff when the proceeds of such sales are to be used for charitable, educational, church, civic or cultural purposes.

No alcoholic beverages, fireworks, or weapons are allowed on the park premises.

Use of inflatables and water slides at the parks is prohibited.

Charcoal grills are available at select parks. If using a personal grill, please make sure they are used in designated area at the park.

Rental groups are responsible for picking up trash, removing decorations, and cleaning up any food/trash on tables or shelter by the end of the reservation timeframe. Recycling bins and trash receptacles are located near the shelter at each park.

Please report damage or problems to the Lincoln County Parks and Recreation Department at 704.748.1518. If no answer, please leave a message or if IMMEDIATE attention is needed, call the Lincoln County Communications Center, non-emergency number 704.735.8202.

Any damage to the property must be repaired and any loss replaced at the renter's expense. The person signing the application is responsible for the condition of the facility and all damages.

In making this facility available to sponsors and the general public, Lincoln County, its Officials and employees, and the local committee or board regulating this facility shall be held harmless and shall assume no responsibility or liability for any loss or damage which may occur during the use of the premises as governed by the policies and procedures.

Lincoln County Sheriff's Department has full authority to enforce all the regulations pertaining to Lincoln County parks and recreation facilities.
