

## Public Notice

Pursuant to N.C. Gen. Stat. § 131E-13(d), the Board of Commissioners (the “Board”) of Lincoln County (the “County”) is providing notice that it plans to consider declaring its intent to sell or otherwise convey its home health agency, Lincoln County Home Health Agency, in a manner consistent with the governmental purpose and which ensures the continued provision of quality care to the communities it serves, at its regular meeting to be held at 6:30 pm on Monday, May 4, 2015. The meeting will be held in the James W. Warren Citizens Center located at 115 West Main Street, Lincolnton, North Carolina.

Upon such declaration of intent, the Board plans to issue a Request For Proposal (“RFP”), related to the sale of its home health agency. By this Notice, the Board also solicits any other party interested in participating in the RFP to contact the Lincoln County Health Director, Margaret Dollar, in writing by May 4, 2015 at [mdollar@lincolncounty.org](mailto:mdollar@lincolncounty.org). Upon receipt of an acceptable proposal, if any, as shall be determined by the Board in its sole discretion, the Board intends to negotiate terms with the applicable respondent in a manner consistent with its governmental purpose.
